Easter Chocolate Crackles

Ingredients

- 200 grams milk or dark chocolate broken up
- 1/2 cup butter softened
- 3 cups coco pops/rice bubbles



Method

- 1. Line 24 mini muffins cups with paper liners.
- 2. In a large saucepan, combine the chocolate and butter and melt over medium-low heat.
- 3. Stir in the cereal, coating thoroughly.
- 4. Divide among the muffin cups and refrigerate for 2 hours to set.
